- The STT Exchange environment allows you to manage your department email, calendar, contacts, and tasks with a relatively easy setup.
- Any device connected to the department email system may contain confidential information or student data within those emails. Treat any connected device the same way you would treat confidential data. Report any loss or theft immediately.

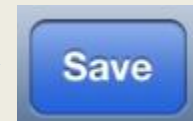

Other Devices

While not a step-by-step instruction guide, these settings will generally allow you to utilize your mobile device with the STT exchange server. Find a spot in your device to add a new email account, and use the following settings:

- Server Type: Exchange
- Delivery Type: Push
- Email Address: (yourusernamehere)@stt.msu.edu
- Password: (yourloginpasswordhere)
- Mail Server: mail.stt.msu.edu
- Domain: STTWIN
- Description: Up to you, usually 'STT Email'
